Как нужно исполнять сочинение

Все исполнители:

Общие указания

В инструментальных партиях указаны цифры - 1, 2, 3

Эти цифры можно играть как в записанном порядке, так и в любом из следующих возможных:

Исполнители могут выбрать как одинаковый для всех порядок цифр, так и различный (при этом он может быть как неповторным, так и повторяться у одного, или нескольких инструменталистов)

Между цифрами (двойная тактовая черта) - нужно делать весьма продолжительную паузу (30-40 секунд)

Указания по синхронизации:

Какой из исполнителей начинает играть пьесу - следует определить на репетициях. Ни в коем случае нельзя начинать исполнение всем вместе! Так же не следует вступать друг за другом в имитационном порядке (или заранее заготовить точный порядок вступлений")

В течение всей пьесы - каждый исполнитель должен максимально сосредоточиться на исполнении именно своей партии. Малейшая

синхронизация - в данной пьесе представляется недопустимой. Это касается и генеральных пауз - они должны выдерживаться каждым исполнителем, но не в ансамбле с другими; что, тем не менее, не исключает их совпадения у нескольких исполнителей одновременно.

Сочинение завершается в тот момент, когда последний из исполнителей доигрывает свою партию до конца (по этой причине нужно выдержать довольно долгую общую паузу после завершения сочинения - в районе 30-40 секунд)

Медные:

Здесь важно то, что расположения исполнителей (от начального, и до конечного) должны соблюдаться всеми музыкантами одновременно. Визуальные действия (игра сидя, игра стоя, игра при ходьбе) исполнители не должны друг с другом синхронизировать (как и музыкальные действия)

Передвижения музыкантов по сцене, и перемены положений, не должны быть ни резкими, ни торопливыми

Фортепиано:

Крайне желательно менять расположение инструмента между разделами (чтобы каждые три раза оно не повторялось). В случае выполнения - следует избегать излишне быстрых и суетливых движений

How to perform the work

All performers:

General instructions

Instrumental parts have rehearsal marks: 1, 2, 3 etc.

These marks can be performed in the listed order or in any of the following:

Artists can choose the same order of marks or different (in this case it may be as non repeated as repeated in one or more instrumental parts)

Between the marks (double bar line) you need to do a very long pause (30-40 seconds)

Instructions for synchronization:

Which of the artists begin to play the piece would be defined at the rehearsals. In no case the performance shouldn't start tutti! So one should not start in imitation order (or prepare the exact order of starts).

Throughout the piece each artist should be maximally focused on the performance of his part. The smallest synchronization in this piece is unacceptable. This applies to the general pauses - they must be maintained by each performer, but not in the ensemble with others, that, however, does not exclude general pauses coincidence of several performers simultaneously.

The piece will be completed when the last of the artists reach the end of his part (for this reason a long pause after the completion of the overall composition - around 30-40 seconds - is necessary)

Brass:

It is important that the space location of performers (from the beginning to the final) must be respected by all the musicians together. Artists do not have to synchronise their visual acts (playing sitting down, standing up, while walking) as well as musical performance.

Performers movement on the stage and their space location change must be neither abrupt nor hasty.

Piano:

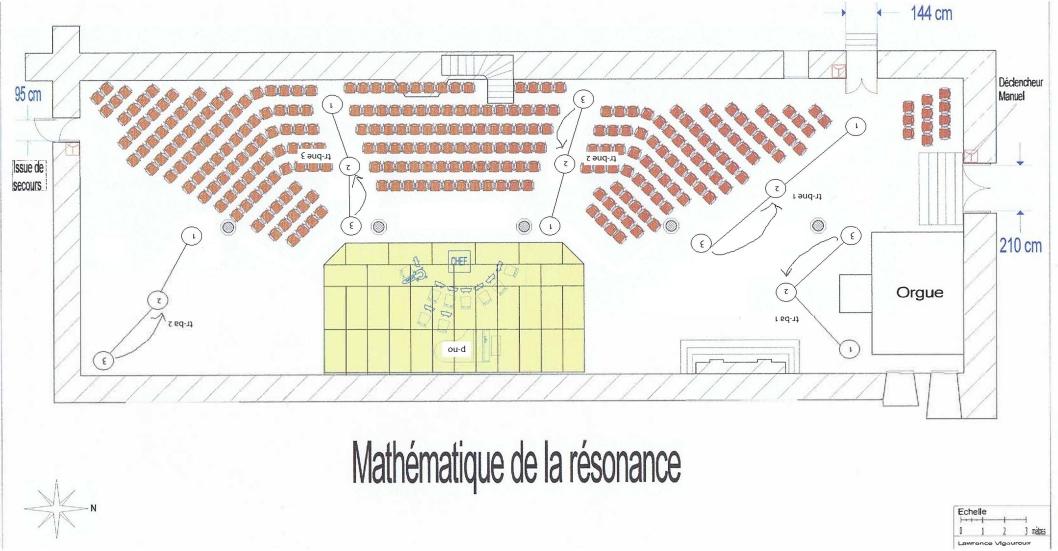
It is highly desirable to change the location of the instrument between the piece parts (so that every three times it does not recur). One should avoid excessively rapid movements.

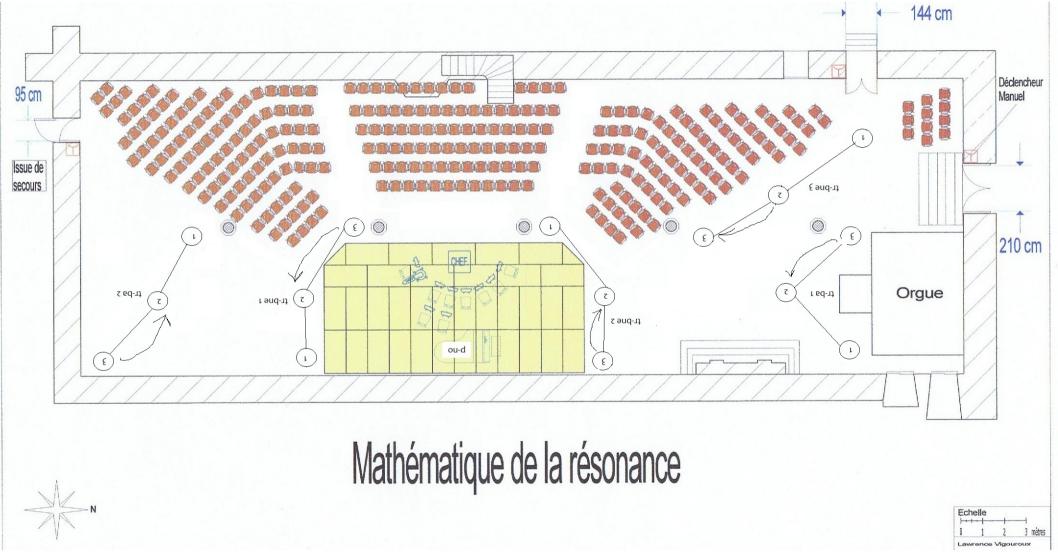
